

Autism Prevalence:

1:59 children are diagnosed with autism
 1:37 boys are diagnosed with autism
 1:151 girls are diagnosed with autism
 Boys are 4 times more likely than girls to be diagnosed with autism.

Autism and IQ:

44% - Average to Above Average
 25% - Borderline
 31% - Intellectual Disability

Autism Co-Morbidities:

30-61% - ADHD
 50% - Chronic sleep problems
 11-40% - Anxiety
 26% adults—Depression
 8x more likely to have a chronic gastrointestinal disorder
 1:3—Epilepsy
 4-35% - Schizophrenia

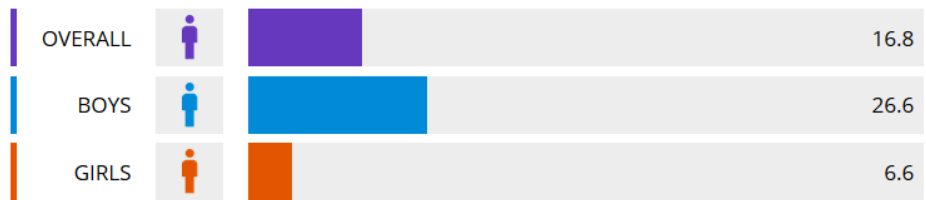
Approximately 50,000 teens with autism age out of the school system annually.

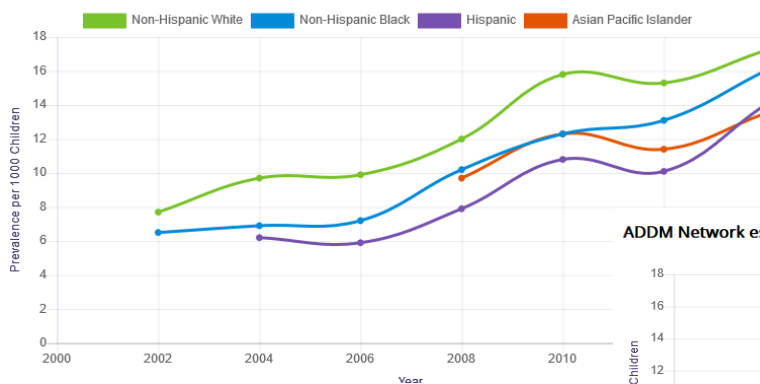


For every 1 GIRL, 4 BOYS were identified with ASD.
