PAYMENTS:

1. You will receive an invoice at the end of every month with the total amount you owe for the classes that the individual participated in. We will need to know who to invoice (Parent, Guardian, Individual, or Rep. Payee) and where to send. **You will need to put this information on the Registration Form.**

- If an individual has signed up for an activity that requires us to buy tickets ahead of time (**ex: Fireside, Sporting events, etc.**), and they do not attend the activity/class, they will be responsible for the ticket price, and an invoice will be sent. The only exception to this is if there was a medical emergency.
- All activities/classes are set up on a calendar with persons attending listed. All staff are aware of scheduled activities/classes and are sent reminders weekly
- When registering for a class, you reserve a slot that helps us decide the supplies that we purchase, the number of reservations that we make as well as the number of teachers that we schedule. Individuals are counted in the total number of students, which determines whether the class is being held.

2. PRE PAYMENTS: Can be sent and are always welcomed.
